APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF OUTSIDE LIBERAL ARTS COURSES

It is recommended that course approval be obtained before the end of the Spring Semester. Courses must be approved before the work is undertaken.

REGULATIONS

1. SCHOOL: Courses may be taken only at accredited schools. Online and external courses are unacceptable. At SCW, students who have completed 60 credits may not take courses at community colleges. Economics, Physics and Speech courses from community colleges are unacceptable.
2. WEEKS: English Dept. courses must meet for at least five weeks and include a research paper. All other departments require a minimum of four calendar weeks.
3. AMOUNT OF CREDIT:
A maximum of 4 credits may be taken during a 4-week period.
A maximum of 7 credits may be taken during a 5-week period.
A maximum of 8 credits may be taken during a 6-week period.
A maximum of 10 credits may be taken during any one summer.
Credits taken on the quarter system, will be converted to corresponding semester credits (e.g. 5 quarter credits = 3 semester credits.)
4. GRADES: Credit will be given only for grades of **C or higher**. P (Pass) is not acceptable. The grades are not included in the Stern College cumulative average.
5. CREDITS IN RESIDENCE AT SCW NEW YORK CAMPUS:
84 credits and 60% of the credits in the major and minor must be taken in residence.

PROCEDURES

1. COURSE APPROVAL:
 - a. A list of approved courses at the most frequently attended institutions will be available in the Office of the Registrar and online at www.yu.edu/schedule. These courses do not require faculty signatures. Submit the completed form to the Registrar.
 - b. If a course is not on the approved list, **attach a catalogue description and syllabus of the course** to this form and bring it to the appropriate faculty for evaluation and signature. A list of faculty can be found at www.yu.edu/schedule. Submit the completed form, with faculty signatures, to the Registrar
2. TRANSCRIPT: At the completion of the course, **you must** order an official transcript to be sent to the following address:
